Then washes the dirt off you. (2 Corinthians 5:17)


He opens you up and scoops out all the yucky stuff.

RAMBLINGS OF THE REVEREND REDACTOR



WHAT A GREAT CELEBRATION! So many people were involved in making last Saturday's Mass and reception happen I dare not try to list names because I KNOW I will forget someone. But it was a great joy to see so many people coming to share time and company (and that WONDERFUL food!) and I rather hated to see it end. God bless you all. These events are the proof that while we may be a different kind of parish, we are very much a parish, and we

support and take care of one another and we can celebrate outside of Mass as well as in Church.

Speaking of celebrations, in 4 weeks we will be celebrating the great Solemnity of Christ the King, marking the end of the liturgical year, and 4 weeks after that, Christmas Eve and the great celebration of the birth of Christ. Between now and then we will have the installation of another group of Lectors, and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist who have completed the workshops in those areas. We will formally introduce the First Communion and the Confirmation candidates, so as the parish prays for them during the year, everyone knows the young people we are praying for. Those working with the Care for the Poor and creating a Youth Program are meeting and shortly may have announcements about their activities. And of course, a Children's Mass on November 18 with Fr. Peter Schineller as the Principal Celebrant.

In the past, I understand that one of the Advent season activities has been a Christmas pageant with the children at one of the Advent Masses. Looking at the calendar, it seems it would have to be the 16th, since I know people will travel during Christmas. In my experience the pageant takes the place of the Liturgy of the Word, and can be done with a narrator and actors, so only a few children are faced with memorizing lines.

But if that tradition is going to continue, we need some people to offer to coordinate it. Assembling children, working to put together the pageant elements (I've done this in a couple of churches so I have some experience to share, and I know it has been done here as well.), costumes, rehearsing, coordinating with music – and we are looking at six weeks to put it together. I probably should have raised this sooner, but it is a question that needs to be asked. If we have some folks who would like to take this on (and you do NOT have to be a current parent), let me know. I will help but I know I am NOT the person who should be "in charge." Remember that I will be on retreat from November 1 to 10.

Shortly I hope to have the schedule of Masses for Christmas and for the celebration of January 1st. Because Christmas is a Monday this year, the existing commitments at the places we celebrate for Sunday make scheduling a little trickier than usual. As soon as I know, I will let you know.

But while Christmas is a wonderful celebration, let us not lose sight of the beautiful season of Advent that lets us prepare. As I did for Lent, there will be a daily reflection available on the web site, at our Facebook page and to be emailed directly to those who would like to receive it. If you received the reflections during Lent, you will automatically be on the list for the Advent reflections (unless you tell me to take you off). If you would like to be added, just send me a note.

In the meantime, let us continue to pray for one another.
